Mr. Billups is Greensboro Branch Manager and an Officer of Anderson & Associates. His duties include administrative responsibilities and technical guidance of our North Carolina and South Carolina Operations.

Prior to joining Anderson & Associates, Mr. Billups served as Vice President and Director of Engineering for Powell Associates, North Myrtle Beach, SC (10-years); MG Engineering and Construction Co., Peachtree City, GA (3-years); and President of Billups and Associates, PA, Raleigh, NC (8 years).

He has a broad-based background in civil engineering, having served as project manager and design engineer in the land-development, water and wastewater, stormwater management, and structural sub-disciplines. His project types have included schools, subdivisions, shopping centers, industrial parks, resort complexes, entertainment and amusement complexes, water system studies and distribution and treatment facilities designs, wastewater system studies and collection, pumping and treatment facilities designs, and structural analysis and design. He has long-standing relationships with local, state and federal permitting and funding agencies.

Mr. Billups' project types have ranged from site design and development for individual commercial out parcels to Project Management of the initial development and programming for a \$35 million + combined wastewater/stormwater management program. As an example of Mr. Billups diverse capabilities, for the latter project, he developed a conceptual program outline which received a letter of commendation from the then Governor James B. Hunt, Jr., and he also prepared draft legislation, subsequently introduced by State Representative David Redwine and passed by the NC General Assembly, authorizing Water and Sewer Authorities to establish stormwater management utilities within their jurisdictions, and to develop such utilities using a system of user charges.

Mr. Billups currently serves on the Consulting Engineers Council of North Carolina A-E Coordinating (State Building) Committee. He previously served as technical member representative to the Peachtree City, GA ad-hoc Watershed Protection and Wetlands Committees. Just prior to moving to Greensboro, NC, Mr. Billups was recommended by the City of North Myrtle Beach, SC, staff as a candidate for the appointment to the North Myrtle Beach Board of Adjustments.
